

45 WATER INSTALLATION COSTS, THETFORD ROAD

It was agreed that the allotment holders were responsible for the paths surrounding their plots and that the Council was responsible for the wider areas and hedge.

49 BUDGET 2010/2011

It was agreed that Litter and Dog bins be increased to £1000, Repairs and maintenance to £2000, Cemetery Maintenance to £1300 and Churchyard Railings to £2500.

Expenditure for the Town Gardener was deferred until after the meeting of the Full Council.

50 BRICK POSTS ST MARY'S CHURCH

A request from Councillor Walls to repair the posts to the side gate of the church was discussed and agreed that no action should be taken until the tree work had been completed.

51 CHURCHYARD FUNDING

Councillor Wassell explained that a grant could be applied for from Breckland Pride and the Wensum Valley Trust for churchyard maintenance.

It was agreed to apply for a grant.

52 THETFORD ROAD FOOTWAYS

The condition of the footways on Thetford Road was discussed.

RESOLVED

That a letter be written to Norfolk County Council Highways to ask that they look at upgrading the footways on Thetford Road.
