73 NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSALS-WAYLAND LUNCHEON CLUB

The Chairman confirmed that a meeting had been held with Norfolk County Council and the luncheon club trustees when the problems with the kitchen equipment had been highlighted.

Option 1 To install an air inlet vent; this would involve knocking a hole in the wall of the building and installing a vent through the kitchen. Norfolk County Council did not think that planning approval would be given and costs would be approximately £10,000.

Option 2 Application to EDF energy would be needed to install three phase electricity and changing the kitchen equipment from gas to electricity. The inlet for electricity was at the rear of Wayland Hall with the outlet to the kitchen to the front of Wayland Hall therefore involving substantial wiring around the hall. This was considered to be the most cost effective option.

Option 3 was to relocate to a different venue.

RESOLVED

That the Council give permission for Norfolk County Council to apply to EDF energy to install three phase to Wayland Hall at no cost to Watton Town Council.

The chairman reminded members that no decision had been made on whether the Council would remain at Wayland hall or relocate to another building.

It was proposed by Councillor Crabtree and seconded by Councillor Gilbert and

That the Council remain at Wayland Hall.
